Log in to Cornell Blackboard

You can log in to Cornell Blackboard at <https://blackboard.cornell.edu/webapps/login/> using your Cornell NetID and password. Once you're logged in, select our course from the "Fall 2017" list and navigate to the course home page.

If you are registered for the course and cannot log in to Blackboard OR you can log in but do not see ECON 1110 as one of your courses, please contact me as soon as possible.

Download and review the PDF file of the Course Syllabus

Purchase textbook and MindTap access

The textbook for this course is Mankiw, *Principles of Microeconomics*, 8th Edition (Cengage). An electronic version of the textbook (eBook) is included with your subscription to the MindTap companion online program. A subscription to MindTap is required for the course. The syllabus contains information on your options for purchasing the textbook and an access code to MindTap.

Create iClickerCloud Polling account and purchase subscription

We will be using iClickerCloud polling in class. You will need to create a polling account using your Cornell email address here: <https://app.reef-education.com/#/login>. When creating your account, please use your Cornell email address. Please note that you will need a subscription to the polling software. Physical iClicker devices will not work in this class. You will need to run the software on a laptop, tablet, mobile phone, etc. More information for creating your account, compatible devices (phones, tablets, computers, etc.) is provided in the "Getting Started" folder in Blackboard.
