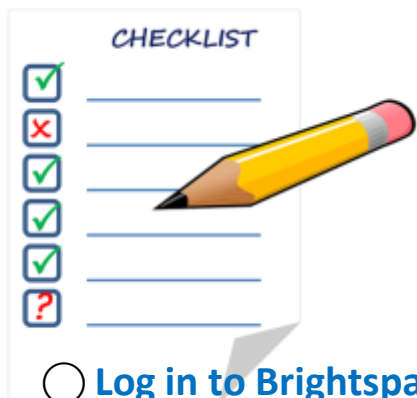

Log in to Brightspace

This semester, our course will be participating in the Cornell University LMS Pilor Program. We will be using Brightspace as our online learning management system. You can log in to Brightspace at <https://cornell.brightspace.com/d2l/login> using your Cornell NetID and password. Please note that we are *not* using Blackboard.

If you are registered for the course and cannot log in to Brightspace OR you can log in but do not see ILRLE 2400 as one of your courses, please contact me as soon as possible.

Create iClickerCloud Polling account and purchase subscription

We will be using iClickerCloud polling in class. You will need to create a polling account using your Cornell email address here: <https://app.reef-education.com/#/login>. When creating your account, please use your Cornell email address. Please note that you will need a subscription to the polling software. Physical iClicker devices will not work in this class.
